ELIZABETH GUYTON

(Died 1823)

Will written 10 December 1822 and probated 22 July 1823

Harford County, Maryland

I will to Margaret Norrard one feather bed, 2 sheets and blankets and 2 pillows, and a quilt, also one-half my wearing apparel. To Mary Leaff wife of Edmond Leaff, one feather bed, bolster, two sheets, a blanket, two quilts; also the other half of my wearing apparel. To Elizabeth Pruet, \$100, one side saddle, one flax hatchet. To Margaret Pruet \$100, one hand painted chest, brass candlesticks. To Benjamin Pruet, \$100. To Elisha Guiton \$300, one desk, a Bible, and no more. To Elizabeth Guiton [daughter of Elisha] half-dozen Chany [china] cups and saucers and half a dozen silver spoons and \$10. After my funeral expenses and the aforesaid legacy are fully paid, that the balance of my estate (if any) be equally divided between Elisha Guiton, Elizabeth Pruet, Margaret Pruet, share and share alike. I do hereby appoint Elisha Guiton and Elizabeth Pruet executors of this my last will and testament.
