Will signed 30 November 1822 and probated 25 August 1824

Baltimore County, Maryland

Abstracts of will of Underwood Guyton signed 30 November 1822 and probated 25 August 1824:

Legatees: Children, Benjamin, Henry, Isaiah, Abraham, Vinson, Ruth Watkins, Betsey Colegate, & Nelly Combs. Wife Priscilla, dau. Sarah & Rebecca, who are named executors. Witnesses: Joseph Slee, N. Baker, & Thomas Gorsuch

The Last Will of Underwood Guiton of Baltimore Co. MD, signed 30 Nov. 1822; proved 25 Aug. 1824 names wife Priscilla, sons Benjamin, Henry, Isaiah, Abraham, John, Vinsin [Vincent]; daughters Ruthe Watkins, Betsy Coalgate, Nelly Combs, Rebecka and Sarah Guiton. Rebecka and Sarah are named as executrixes and heirs of his estate upon the death of his wife [Priscilla died 11 Aug. 1828] along with the following Black people: Sophire, Richard, Jenny, Ann, Maria, Eliza, Jack and Wesley. To his other children he bequeathed to each one Shilling and no more, having already provided for them. A \$2200 bond was recorded on 25 Aug. 1824 and no release or other estate record has been found.
