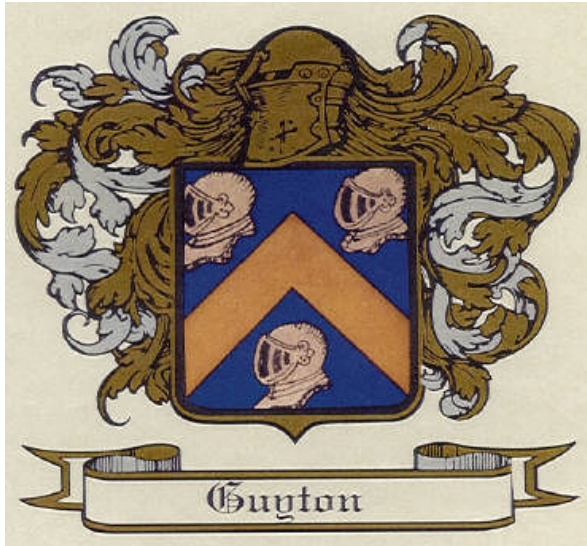


# Guyton Ancestry

## Family crests



A modern representation of the Guyton coat of arms (*left*). This is clearly based on an earlier version taken from Rietstap's *Armorial General* (*bottom left*) which in turn is based on the coat of arms belonging to the Guyton de Morveau family in Burgundy (*bottom right*). This was one of several Guiton/Guyton families in France which gained the right to bear arms.



THE GUYTON COAT OF ARMS HEREBY ILLUSTRATED IS OFFICIALLY DOCUMENTED IN RIETSTAP'S *ARMORIAL GENERAL*. THE ORIGINAL DESCRIPTION OF THE ARMS (SHIELD) IS AS FOLLOWS:

"D'AZUR AU CHEV. D'OR, ACC. DE TROIS CASQUE D'ARG."

WHEN TRANSLATED THE BLAZON ALSO DESCRIBES THE ORIGINAL COLORS OF THE GUYTON ARMS AS:

"BLUE; A GOLD CHEVRON ACCOMPANIED BY THREE SILVER HELMETS."
