Abstract of will of Jacob Guyton dated 17 November 1846, probate date not given:

Jacob Guyton Box 16 # 210. Probate Judge Office, Pickens, S.C.

I Jacob Guyton, being under affliction but of sound mind and memory ... I will to my beloved wife Anna Guyton all my land, 165 acres with everything belonging to the premises after my just debts are paid, so long as she remain a widow. If she remarry I will only one bed and furniture and her wearing apparel. I will my dtr. Polly an equal share and partaker of all profits and benefits arising from said premises. At the close of either of their lives the survivor to take and possess all. I appoint Jacob Lewis with my wife as executors ... dated 17 Nov. 1846. Wit: James Lewis, Isiah Wood, Wm. X Nix. Signed Jacob Guyton. Probate date not given.
